Study and Work Programme - 25 Weeks

Need to know

- > Students from Turkey need a visa before traveling to Ireland.
- > We will provide students with the necessary letters for visa application, once full payment for their course is made.
- > Bookings are provisional until we receive a copy of the visa. We will then confirm full course and accommodation information.
- > Students must take a recognised exam at the end of their programme. International House Dublin is an official Cambridge Exam Centre and students who choose a Cambridge Exam, will sit the exam at our school at the end of their course. Students who choose to take an IELTS Exam, must book and sit it themselves. These students will be refunded their exam fee of €150, upon proof of their exam results.
- > Students can work part-time (maximum of 20 hours per week) for their entire stay of 8 months. Students can work full-time (maximum of 40 hours per week), during their 10 weeks' holidays. Students on the Study and Work Programme can only take their 10 weeks' holidays during the following months: June, July, August, September, December-January.
- > Students must inform us of when they wish to take their 10 weeks' holidays, when they arrive. Once we register these dates with the Immigration Office, they cannot be changed.
- > Minimum wage in Ireland is €9.55.

We endeavour to provide the most accurate and up to date visa information, but we do advise all students to check with the Irish Embassy prior to booking and travel.
