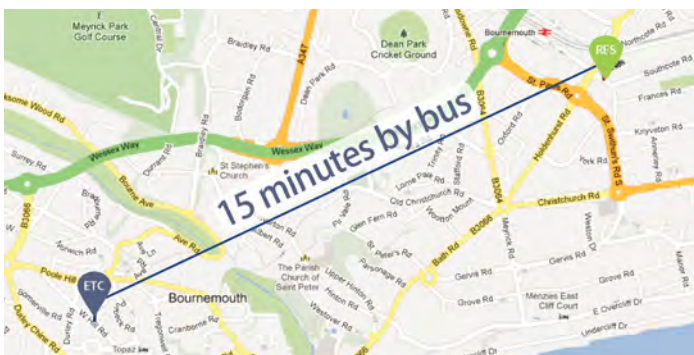
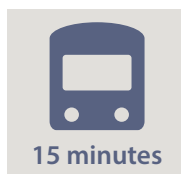
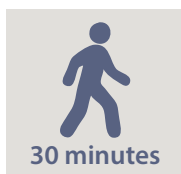
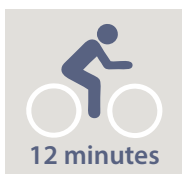
Dorchester House

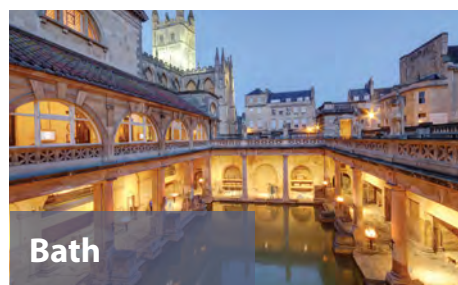
Corfe Castle
