Students that choose our Late Morning Schedule will have the chance to choose one of our Signature Elective Classes. These classes are good for students who are looking to focus on a specific area of interest. Students can choose from:

• Business English

Students will learn to function effectively in an English work environment. The class will cover a wide range of business language skills, including presentations, networking, negotiation, telephoning, business writing, and more. Each class introduces new vocabulary and commonly used business idioms. Students will participate in real problem solving activities to practice their business English communication skills. There is also class time to review specific problem areas in grammar and speaking that relate to the activities. The goal is to make students more comfortable and more confident working in English.



• Speaking and Pronunciation

Students will learn the useful vocabulary and build the confidence they need to speak English. The class focuses on clear, accurate speech with lots of guided practice.

• TOEFL/University Prep

• English Through Film

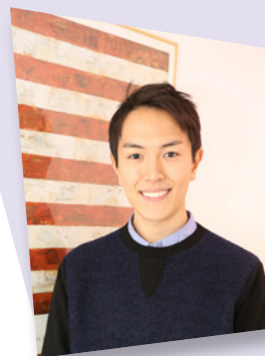
Students will improve their vocabulary and enhance their understanding of language and culture by watching famous movies and participating in discussions.

Live in a Student Residence

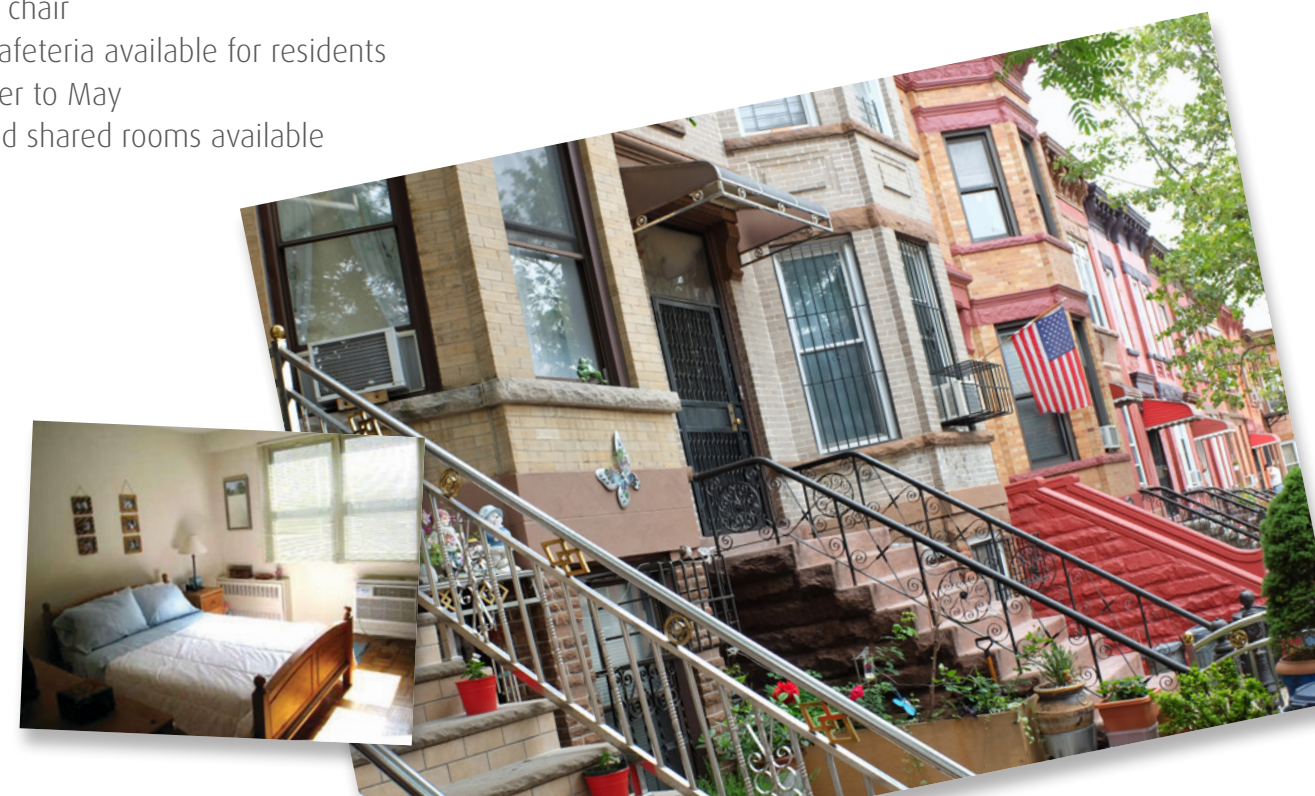

Live with a Host Family

One of the best ways to practice English while learning about American culture is to live in a homestay with a host family. Most homestays have a furnished single room, but double rooms are available for two people booking together. Wi-Fi is available.

All Homestays include a continental breakfast. Dinner plans are available outside of Manhattan. The continental breakfast is made available at a time that is mutually convenient (coffee, tea or milk, bread or toast, fruit, jam, butter). Premium homestays include a private bathroom. Standard homestays include a shared bathroom.
