COURSE BREAKS

General English students taking courses of 9 weeks or more can arrange a 1 week break (Monday-Friday) after completing 8 weeks of study, with a corresponding extension of course ending dates. Students studying for 24+ weeks can take a 1 week break for every 12 weeks of stay (maximum 2 weeks at any one time).

Students must ensure that arrangements comply with their visa conditions, where relevant. Students should select this option and choose dates at the time of enrolment to avoid problems with visas or payment of amendment fees.

Excursions do not take place on the day of the student's arrival or departure.

The number of levels available in classes for the Junior and the Family course (children classes) will depend on overall student numbers in any given week. Various factors are taken into account when classing young learners including age, stage of development and nationality as well as language level.
