### PAYMENTS

Payments must be made by bank wire transfer or credit card and must be received a full 14 days prior to the course start date. A deposit or initial fees must be paid immediately upon booking. A booking confirmation will only be sent when either initial fees or a deposit has been received. Bank details are provided on the invoice. Payment bank transfer fees must be absorbed by the sender (including any intermediary bank charges).

### VISAS

- 1.Zoni Language Center is not responsible for decisions made by any embassy or immigration authority regarding entry visas or visa extensions.
- 2.Payment must be received in full prior to any visa documents being issued.
- 3.Visa advice can only be given by the appropriate Embassy, Consulate or High Commission. Students should contact these local authorities to ensure they are allowed to enter and study in their chosen location.
- 4.It is the responsibility of the applicant to ensure that the most updated regulations/processes are being followed. Zoni cannot be held responsible for any visa regulation changes which occur after the booking has been confirmed in compliance with the then existing regulations.
- 5.A charge will be made eachtime documents have to be sent based on destination and courier service used.These charges as subject to change based on market rates. If a visaapplication is rejected and Zoni receives written evidenceat least 7 days prior to arrival, fess will be refunded in full, less any bank charges or credit cards service percentage fees.AdditionallyZoni will deduct any nonrefundablecosts such as tuition fees, registrationand mailing charges.
- 6.A cancellation fee will apply according to the school destination.
- 7.Zonireserves the right to offer alternative accommodations should we receive a positive visa application result in fewerthan 7 working days prior to arrival. Students may incuradditional charges for these arrangements.
- 8.Should the arrival day be postponed due to delayedvisa applications Zoni cannot guarantee reservation of the original accommodations.
- 9.If any additional charges are incurred reserving theaccommodation for the student, Zoni reserves the right topass these charges on.
- 10.US only: Zoni is authorized under federal law to enroll F-1non-immigrant students. By law, to issue the I-20 form, Zoni must receivewith the enrollment form: the student's homeaddress, a copy of the student's passport, proof of sufficientfunds to meet tuition and living expenses through a current(60 days or less) bank statement or letter from eitherthe sponsoring person's or institution's bank.Sponsors must also provide an affidavit of support.

### REFUNDS AND CANCELLATION FEES

All students attending a Zoni language Centers will be subject to the destination-specific applicable state or provincial Enrollment & Refund Agreement policies. If Zoni's refund policies differ from state/ provincial agreements, refunds will be processed according to the state/provincial policies, available upon request in each center.

- 1.Written notification of cancellation must be submitted in order to provide refunds. All refunds are made to the original fee payer (according to destination).
- 2.Students who require a visa-status/student permit/ temporary residence permit may not be able to shorten their course due to the terms of their visa-status or residence permit.
- 3.In the event that a refund is due, prorated refunds will be calculated on a weekly basis. When determining the number of weeks, Zoni will consider a partial week of attendance as the same as if a whole week were completed, even though the studentwas present at least one day during the scheduled week.

### Accommodation Cancellation Or Postponement Prior To Arrival For All Schools

Zoni Language Centers Accommodation: Students cancelling or postponing fewer than 14 days before arrival will be charged a one week accommodation fee at the standard accommodation rate and accommodation placement fee.

Third Party Accommodations:Non-Zoni accommodations (i.e. accommodationscontracted by Zoni through external suppliers) havedifferent cancellation terms. For hotels and self-cateringapartments booked through Zoni but not featured in the Zoni Price List, reservations must be cancelled or postponed30 days prior to arrival to avoid a cancellation fee whichmay amount to the full stay charge. For this reasonwe remind you that in cases of hotel or

self-cateringapartment bookings, payment in full is expected onemonth prior to arrival. Zoni will inform you of the terms when confirming the booking.

### Accommodation Cancellation After Arrival

Students leaving their accommodation must give noticein writing 4 weeks prior to termination. After deductingthe price of accommodations used, including the requirednotice period, charged at standard accommodation rates,students will be refunded the remaining balance.If the 4 week notice period is not provided a cancellationfee equal to 4 weeks of the accommodation cost will apply.Please note: Certain accommodation options may besubject to special cancellation charges. Should thesediffer from the terms above, students will be notified at the time ofcancellation.

### Cancellation Prior To Arrival

- 1.Students cancelling 14 days or fewer prior to the courseor accommodation start date (whichever comes first), orstudents who have had their visa application rejectedwill be refunded fees received in full; less non-refundablecharges such as registration fees, accommodation placementfee, courier fees and student insurance fees, the value ofthese fees vary according to region, the costs are listed foreach school in the price list.
- 2.Refunds will be made within 45 days.Course cancellation, reduction after arrival or "no shows":
  - a.For courses of 4 weeks or fewer, lessons cannot becancelled. Tuition fees are not refundable.
  - b.For courses of 5 weeks & over, students must advise Zoni by the Friday prior to coursetermination at the latest.

### Cancellations In US Only

- 4.Students who terminate their course after the 12th week,but before the mid-point of the original course duration:will be charged a prorated amount of tuition at the no discounted rate found in the Zoni Price List.
- 5.Students who terminate their course after the mid- pointof their course will not be refunded.

### Refund Due Dates

- 1.For students cancelling before arrival, refunds will be made within 45 calendar days of the first scheduled day of class or the documented date of cancellation, whichever is earlier.
- 2.For students cancelling after arrival, the refund due will be paid within 45 calendar days from notification of the cancellation.
