Royal Tunbridge Wells

Royal Tunbridge Wells, with a population of about 56,000, is situated in "The Garden of England". Ideally located between London and the South Coast, it is one of only three "Royal" towns in England.

In the 17th century people came to "take the waters", believing it could cure the sick. You can still see the spring and try the water today, from Easter to September. Royal Tunbridge Wells is a popular place with lots going on – cafés, restaurants, night clubs, a museum, a large shopping centre, theatres, a jazz club, a library, parks, gyms, tennis courts, a modern sports centre, an out-of-town multi-screen cinema, bowling and shopping centre.

The surrounding countryside is beautiful, with picturesque villages, ancient castles, magnificent stately homes and some of the finest views in England.

Central London is fifty minutes away by train, perfect for exploring at the weekends. Many of the most popular sights, such as the Houses of Parliament, Buckingham Palace, Westminster Abbey, Trafalgar Square and the London Eye are easy to visit on foot from Charing Cross Station.

To the south is the seaside, with both Brighton and Hastings near enough for day trips.

If you do not have any special language needs (such as work-related language), then group classes are ideal for you.

You will study with other students of a similar English level and will benefit from plenty of communication practice to help you become more fluent. You will gain confidence, learn to express yourself more naturally and understand what people say to you more easily.

FAST TRACK 1-TO-1

mornings, afternoons or full-time

You have a teacher to yourself – two if you choose full-time one-to-one lessons. This course is designed specifically for your needs; it is effective and makes the most of your time here. It is suitable if you would like to achieve as much as possible within a limited time or if you need to focus on specific language areas for work, studies or exams. For example, a marketing executive might want to prepare for an important presentation, or a school student might need to get ready for an exam in English. We will send you a needs analysis in advance and call you if you would like to discuss any specific aspects of your course, or if we need to check your English level.

IELTS EXAMINATION

afternoons

IELTS is one of the most widely used tests for people who want to study or work in Englishspeaking countries.

On this afternoon course, you will prepare and practise for the exam, learning useful techniques and tips from your teacher. The small classes give you lots of opportunity to make good progress.

You can take the exam at the end of your course if you wish. The exam usually takes place on a Saturday so you will need to make your return travel arrangements for the Sunday.

AFTERNOON TEA

ENGLISH GARDENS

If you are a more experienced rider some areas you might cover are dressage, lunge and jump lessons.

Summer Courses for Teenagers (16-18)

THE COURSE

This course is designed for people aged between 16 and 18 who are still at school. It is a short course with lessons and a fun programme of activities in your summer holidays.

THE LESSONS

You will practise your grammar, improve your vocabulary and everyday expressions, and work on the skills of speaking, listening, reading and writing.

You will study with other young learners and adults in classes of mixed nationalities with a maximum of ten students per class.

We will help you to develop both your fluency and your confidence in English and improve your marks at school in your home country. There are two types of course:

ENGLISH & ACTIVITIES

This course has 15 hours (20 lesson units) of tuition a week, activities on three afternoons and three evenings each week and a day trip to London each Saturday.

ENGLISH INTENSIVE & ACTIVITIES

This course has 22.5 hours (30 lesson units) of tuition a week, activities on three evenings each week and a day trip to London each Saturday.

EXTRA LESSONS

If you would like some additional help with your lessons, you can book some Support Course sessions (see page 6).

ACCOMMODATION

Your accommodation will be in a single room and you will be the only person of your mother tongue in the family - unless you ask to share with a friend.

You will have breakfast and your evening meal with the family and packed lunches all week.

PROGRAMME OF ACTIVITIES

The programme of activities includes sports, visits to places of interest and cultural activities. Typical activities are tennis, a tour of Tunbridge Wells, a quiz night, bowling, rounders, cinema, a trip to the seaside or salsa dancing.

Each course includes two day trips to London with sightseeing, time in Covent Garden, a ride on the London Eye and more. All the activities are accompanied by Cicero leaders.

INCLUDED IN THE PRICE

This course price includes the lessons, course materials, accommodation with a host family, all meals and the full programme of activities with admission fees. The only extras you need are your travel to Tunbridge Wells and pocket money.

TRAVEL

We recommend that you book a flight to Heathrow airport to arrive between 09:00 and 17:00 UK time. You can then book a seat on our transfer coach or minibus. Our leaders will meet you when you arrive at Heathrow and bring you to Tunbridge Wells, where your hosts will be waiting for you.

For the return journey we recommend booking a flight that departs from Heathrow between 13:00 and 18:00. Our leaders will accompany you to the airport and help you check in. They will then stay at the airport until your flight has departed.

If you travel at different times or to different airports, we can book private taxi transfers for you. Please see the dates and prices for details.

INFORMATION FOR PARENTS OF STUDENTS AGED UNDER 18

Our team is there to help if there are any questions or problems. Students are given an emergency contact number where they can always reach Cicero staff who will help outside normal school hours.

When students are not at school or on an organised activity, they can spend their free time with their host families or friends. We will ask them where they will be and when they are returning to their host families every day. Students under 18 should be home by 22:30. If they wish to leave Tunbridge Wells outside the programme of activities they will need written permission from you and permission from the school. As part of our safeguarding policy, all our staff are officially checked. All other adults who might be alone with our students under 18 are also checked or have signed our Suitability to Work with Children form. You can find our full Safeguarding Policy on our website.

The School & Visas

HOW OLD DO I NEED TO BE?

The minimum age for the courses in this brochure is 16, except the Family English course. Occasionally we accept bookings from students aged 15, but only in special circumstances.

WHAT WILL HAPPEN ON MY FIRST DAY AT SCHOOL?

When you arrive our team will be there to welcome you. There is a short written and spoken test which help us to create a profile for you and place you in the right class. We will then show you around the school and give you some information about your stay here before introducing you to your morning class teacher.

HOW IS MY LANGUAGE PROGRESS ASSESSED?

Your teachers will monitor your progress throughout your course and give you a one-to-one progress assessment session every four weeks. They will move you to a higher or lower level if necessary.

WHO ARE THE ENGLISH TEACHERS?

All our teachers are qualified as teachers of English as a foreign language and of a high professional standard.

WHO ARE THE STUDENTS?

Our students are aged 16 upwards and come from all over the world, so you will have plenty of opportunity to practise your English with them, in and outside class.

WHERE ARE THE LESSONS?

Classes are usually held at Cicero but in busy times we hire classrooms in another building in the town, less than ten minutes' walk from the school.

I AM A BEGINNER AND DON'T SPEAK ANY ENGLISH YET - HAVE YOU GOT A COURSE FOR ME?

Yes we have. Fast Track courses are suitable for beginners and give you the perfect opportunity to make good progress within a limited time. You can start with 60 hours of one-to-one lessons and then join a group course when your level is suitable. Group courses are for students who can speak and write a little English, elementary level or above.

IS THE SCHOOL OPEN ON PUBLIC HOLIDAYS?

Yes, we are open from Monday to Friday throughout the year including public holidays, except the Christmas and New Year period.





WHAT EXTRA WORK CAN I DO TO HELP MY ENGLISH?

You can borrow DVDs and library books from us for your free time. Your teacher will guide you about which areas of the language you need to focus on and you can ask for extra work if you feel you need some.

There are many websites and apps which you can use to help your English – speak to your teachers for further advice.

Spending your free time with students of different nationalities is one of the best ways of practising your English without even knowing you are doing it!

I'M STILL NOT QUITE SURE WHICH COURSE I SHOULD BOOK - CAN YOU HELP ME?

Yes we can; finding the right course for you is important and we will take time to help you. You can email, call or use our live online help system. If you tell us what your aims are, we will advise you about the best way of achieving them.

HOW CAN I BOOK A COURSE?

Booking is easy; you can book online or you can

fill in the booking form in our brochure. We can send you an electronic version of the form if you would prefer. We will send you confirmation when we have received your booking.

HOW CAN I PAY FOR MY COURSE?

In the email we send to confirm we have received your booking we will also send you our bank account details and information about different ways of paying.

You pay a £200 deposit to guarantee your place and the rest of your payment, by credit card or bank transfer, is due at least two weeks before your course start date.

DO I NEED A VISA?

If you hold a passport from an EU country, Switzerland, Iceland, Lichtenstein or Norway, you should not need a visa. Otherwise you should check with your nearest British Embassy or Consulate or look at the Foreign and Commonwealth Office website at: www.ukvisas.gov.uk.

If you need a visa to study here, you must book a course with a minimum of 15 hours per week.

IF I AM APPLYING FOR A VISA, WHAT DO I NEED FROM THE SCHOOL?

When you have booked your course and paid the deposit, we will send you a Certificate of Enrolment and an invoice showing your deposit payment and the total fees due. You should send these papers with your visa application.

WHAT HAPPENS IF MY VISA APPLICATION IS REFUSED?

We will refund the money you have paid us, minus an administrative fee of £50. We will need to see the letter of refusal from the British Embassy at least one week before your course start date.

HOW CAN I KEEP IN CONTACT WITH MY FAMILY AND FRIENDS?

You can use the school's free wi-fi internet connection. Most of our host families also have wireless access.

IS THERE A PLACE OF WORSHIP FOR ME IN TUNBRIDGE WELLS?

There are places of worship for people of many different faiths. You will find a list in the information booklet we send you before you start your course. Accommodation & Travel

WHERE WILL I STAY?

We recommend you stay with one of our local host families. Living as part of a family will give you plenty of chance to communicate in English and also experience the English way of life.

WHO ARE THE HOST FAMILIES?

We have a wide range of different host families. Some are young, some are older, some have young children and some older children. They all enjoy looking after their foreign guests while they are studying here.

Our students have different wishes. Some want to stay with a family with children or a family with no children, others prefer to stay with older people. If you have any special wishes, please write them on your booking form and we will do our best to find the right family for you.

HOW DO YOU SELECT THE HOST FAMILIES?

We visit all our families regularly to make sure they and the accommodation are suitable. We have regular contact with the host families and we will select a family which suits your requirements. We only choose the host families where we would be happy to stay ourselves.

I AM A VEGETARIAN - HAVE YOU GOT A FAMILY FOR ME?

Yes, we have families who are happy to cater for more unusual diets. You just need to tell us the details when you book. There may be an extra charge for some diets.

WHAT CAN I EXPECT OF MY HOST FAMILY?

You will have your own room. Your host family will provide you with breakfast and a main evening meal from Monday to Friday, plus lunch at the weekend if you are at home, or a packed lunch if you are out. Your host family will also do your everyday washing for you.

WHERE CAN I GET LUNCH ON SCHOOL DAYS?

There are plenty of sandwich and snack bars, cafés and restaurants in the town. There is also a supermarket 5 minutes' walk from the school. The school also has a small students' room with a hot drinks machine, microwave ovens and a fridge, all of which you may use.

WILL ANY OTHER STUDENTS BE STAYING WITH MY HOST FAMILY?

Some families only host one student and others two or more. The maximum is four, but most families take fewer.

Each student will have his or her own single room and you will be the only student of your nationality and language throughout your stay, unless you request otherwise.



I AM BOOKING A COURSE TOGETHER WITH MY PARTNER -CAN WE SHARE A DOUBLE ROOM?

Yes, you just need to tell us this on your booking form.

WHERE DO THE HOST FAMILIES LIVE?

Most are within 30 minutes' walk of the school, or a short bus ride away. You may choose to buy a bus pass for unlimited bus travel within Tunbridge Wells. You can buy your pass from the driver.

I DON'T WANT TO STAY WITH A HOST FAMILY - IS THERE AN ALTERNATIVE?

Yes. We recommend that you stay with one of our families but there are local hotels and guest houses which provide bed and breakfast. If you let us know what you would like, we can recommend some to you.

WHAT IS THE BEST AIRPORT TO FLY TO?

You can fly to Gatwick, Heathrow, Stansted, London City or Luton airports.

By road, Gatwick is the nearest, just 24 kilometres away; Heathrow is about 98 kilometres. Both airports have regular train services.

Stansted is 104 kilometres away by road with good train connections, but you will need to change trains twice.

London City is near the centre of London; it has a good train connection with one change. Luton Airport is about 134km north of London with a regular train and daily coach services. There is a coach service from each of the airports, but most have only one coach a day and you have to change coaches in London. We can organise a taxi transfer for you from any airport – please see our dates and prices list for full details.

Our website has up to date information about travel to and from Tunbridge Wells, including the Eurostar train service.

Terms & Conditions

1. PAYMENT

A deposit of £200 is payable with your booking. We will send you details of how to pay and your booking will be confirmed as soon as we have received payment.

The rest of the course and all accommodation fees must be received by Cicero no later than two weeks before your course starts. If payment has not been received by then, Cicero reserves the right to cancel the booking.

2. CHANGE OF COURSE

If you start your course and then wish to change to a different course you must give at least two weeks' notice. You can only start the new course on a scheduled starting date. If the total fees are lower than the original price you will receive a credit towards an extension of your course or towards another course at the school to be taken at any time during the twelve months after the change of course. No cash refund will be given. Special Interest courses cannot be changed to other courses.

3. STUDENT HOLIDAYS

If you would like a holiday while you are at Cicero, you must give four week's notice.

Holiday must be taken in complete weeks from Monday to Friday.

4. VISAS

If you need a visa it is your responsibility to ensure that you apply for the correct type and that all the details on your Certificate of Enrolment are correct before you apply for your visa.

5. CANCELLATION

You can cancel your course at any time before the start date. We request that you do this in writing. We will refund the money you have paid less a fee to cover our costs depending on when we receive your cancellation as follows:

- more than 30 days before your course is due to start: £75
- between 30 and 15 days before your course is due to start: 30% of the tuition fees
- between 14 and 7 days before your course is due to start: 45% of the tuition fees
- less than 7 days before your course is due to start: 75% of the tuition fees

If you have booked accommodation there is an additional cancellation charge of one week's accommodation fees if we receive

your cancellation less than 30 days before the accommodation is due to start.

There is an additional cancellation fee of £50 for the cancellation of any Special Interest course regardless of when it is cancelled.

No refund of course fees is given if you wish to cancel your course after it has started but you may defer the remaining weeks to any time within the next twelve months provided you give at least four weeks' notice. If you give less than four weeks' notice then one week will be deducted from the length of the remaining course time. Special Interest courses cannot be deferred.

If you need a visa and your visa is refused we will refund the money you have paid us minus an administrative fee of £50, provided we receive the original or an electronic copy of the letter of refusal at least one week before your course is due to start.

No refund can be given on any airport transfers booked but not used on the dates for which they have been booked or for other services booked and not used.

9. DATA PROTECTION

Information you supply will only be passed on to third parties where this is necessary, for example to host families, taxi drivers, British Council or other inspectors or for security or immigration purposes.

We sometimes take photographs and videos for publicity purposes. If you do not wish to appear in any such materials please inform us in writing before the start of your course, otherwise we have the unreserved right to use such materials.

11. STUDENTS AGED UNDER 18

Parents or guardians accept responsibility for any problems which may arise.

Parents or guardians must explain to students aged under 18 that they must comply with the school's rules. Failure to observe the rules might result in the student being sent home before the end of the course without compensation. In that case it is the responsibility of the parent or guardian to arrange for an adult to collect the student from Tunbridge Wells or to meet the student at the place of arrival and at a time specified by the school.
