The ELI Experience

Academic Year

Our Work & Study programme is ideal for students who want to make significant improvements in their English level while living & working in a beautiful country and experiencing the authentic Irish life. The programme includes 6 months (25 weeks) of tuition, a globally recognised certificate and an 8-week holiday over an 8-month visa.

Ø= O= Entry Requirements

The Work & Study program has a rolling start date with new students starting every week. In total students may study for a total of three consecutive 8-month programmes over 24-months (2 years).

Requirements:

Students must be 18 years of age by the course start date.

⊘ They must have a minimum A1 level of English

⊘ They should be enrolled for a 25-week general English course.


✓ Funds guarantee: Countries that require a visa need proof of €7.000, and for visa waiver countries is €3.000.
After 01 of July, students coming from visa-required countries have to show they have access to at least €10.000 per year and €4.200 for students from visa waiver countries.

Should have at least one week of accommodation confirmed on arrival.

Should have health insurance.

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Our Programs


Our core program is General English 15 hour which focuses on the four main skills (writing, reading, speaking, and listening) while developing each student's individual grammar and vocabulary. Students can upgrade to a 20-hour program with a choice of Speaking Fluency, Business or Academic English. Our curriculum and teaching methodology has been designed to match the highest international standards, yet we personalise our approach so we can meet the needs of every individual learner.

Teaching Methodology

Using a communicative approach our lessons are taught using a task-based method involving topics and themes from everyday life. We use a central course book for each level and teachers supplement these using authentic materials including newspapers, magazines, and a suitable use of technology.

Strong Curriculum

Our curriculum is carefully planned and mapped to the Common European Framework ensuring a global standard. Our curriculum includes a progress test every 6 weeks and a progression test every 12, with a class test every week to ensure you understand and know where you are at every step.





Right to Work & Job Support

We know many of our students are eager to find parttime work while studying with us. All students enrolled on this programme are entitled to work 20 hours per week throughout their course and for the duration of their visa. Students are also entitled to work full-time 40 hours per week during holiday periods.



You can get a job in all sectors, but the employability of a candidate and the time it takes depends on their experience, level of English and the determination to find the right job. There are great opportunities for employment in all industries; especially in the hotel and restaurant industry (hotels, restaurants, cafes, etc.) where there are opportunities for all levels of English and any degree of work experience.

Accommodation

Amongst our many services, we also offer you accommodation in a host family or student residence. The duration of your stay and the type of accommodation, depends on your budget and future plans. However, we recommend trying our housing options for the first 6 weeks of your stay in Ireland.

We offer a choice of homestay or student residences. Irish hospitality is world famous and our hosts ensure that our students have a pleasant and warm stay. Staying in the right homestay is critical to feeling happy and to creating memories that will last a lifetime. All our hosts have been inspected by our team and have passed police checks.

ELI also offers accommodation at a student residence. Staying in a student residence offers a more independent living experience. Our residences are in the city-centre within a short distance of the school and close to all the attractions. Student residences offer single rooms on a self-catering basis and include a range of onsite services.





G Staying back in Ireland

- 1 Study an English course You can choose to study another English course of maximum 2 years, that gives you the chance to stay back, work part-time during the entire stay and experience Irish life!
- 2 Pursue a master's degree This option gives you the chance to come to Ireland on a student visa that allows you to stay in Ireland for at least 3 years (1 year for the course and 2 years after graduation)
- 3 Get sponsored by a company to obtain a work permit - There are 2 types of work permits that one can obtain i.e. Critical skills or General work permit.

After studying English in Ireland

If your interest is in preparing yourself professionally and doing your undergraduate or postgraduate degree, Ireland is the right place for you! This is also one of the most popular alternatives among students who have already completed the period allowed for English studies (2 years) to continue their stay in the country.

If you have a High Intermediate level of English (B2) Colleges, Universities and Technological Institutes make up the fabric of the institutions that offer Higher Education programs in this country.




