
Teaching Methodology

Program Requirements:

- O Participants must be 18 years of age by the course start date.
- O Participants must have a minimum A1 level of English.
- O Non-European students must be enrolled on 25-week program to have the right to work.
- O Proof of Funds: Non-EU Students coming from visa-required countries must show they have access to at least €10.000 per year for personal welfare funding (in addition to tuition fees). Non-EU students from countries that do not require a visa prior to travel are required to prove access to €4,500 for personal welfare funding.
- O Participants should have at least one week of accommodation confirmed on arrival.
- O All participants should have travel and health insurance (provided in non-EU packages)
- O All Non-EU students on 25 programs are required to sit an end of course English exam.
